“Campus Policy on Plastic Waste Management for Ecosystem Protection (SDG 15)”

Misamis University strengthens its implementation of **RA 9003**, the Ecological Solid Waste Management, through strict waste minimization, proper segregation, recycling, and measures to reduce plastic use across campus.

- 1. Mandatory Waste Segregation.** Use color-coded bins: Green – Biodegradable, Black – Residual, Blue/Yellow – Recyclable. “No Segregation, No Disposal” is strictly enforced.
- 2. Ban on Single-Use Plastics and Styrofoam.** Prohibited items include plastic straws, cups, cutlery, sachets, cellophane, and styrofoam containers. Using reusable or biodegradable alternatives is advised.
- 3. Recycling and Composting.** Biodegradables are composted for the campus gardens and the MU established farm. Recyclables are processed through the MRF or sold to buy-back centers.
- 4. Awareness Campaigns.** CEPA materials, orientations, and green campus initiatives will be conducted regularly.

All Colleges and departments are directed to ensure full compliance and promote plastic waste reduction in their respective offices.
