“ Ensuring Healthy and Sustainably Sourced Food on Campus (SDG 15)”

Misamis University, through the College of Agriculture and Forestry (CAF), adopts this policy to ensure that food available on campus is sourced from sustainable farms and responsibly managed agricultural systems, supporting SDG 15 – Life on Land.

1. Instructional Farms:

1.1 Capucao (8 ha): Climate-smart crop production, soil conservation, and organic fertilization.

1.2 Banadero (1 ha): Sustainable rice, livestock, and poultry production using low-impact, biodiversity-friendly practices.

2. Campus Food Provision: MU ensures that a portion of the food consumed on campus comes from these farms, is produced responsibly, and is offered at affordable prices.

All colleges and departments shall support procurement from MU farms, integrate sustainable agriculture into instruction and activities, promote awareness, coordinate with CAF for supply and reporting, and submit annual SDG 15 documentation.

This policy takes effect immediately and forms part of MU's sustainability framework and SDG reporting.
