Policy on Conservation, Restoration, and Sustainable Use of Terrestrial Ecosystems (SDG 15)

Misamis University commits to SDG 15 by adopting this policy to ensure the protection and sustainable management of terrestrial ecosystems affected by the University's research, instruction, extension work, and campus operations.

1. Conservation – Apply biodiversity-friendly practices and avoid destructive land use in all MU activities.
2. Restoration – Support reforestation and habitat rehabilitation in partnership with DENR, LGUs, and PAMBs.
3. Sustainable Use – Ensure MU farms and fieldwork follow responsible land, water, and resource-use practices.
4. Instruction & Research – Integrate ecosystem stewardship into curricula and prioritize sustainability-focused studies.
5. Monitoring & Reporting – Conduct regular field assessments and submit annual reports to the SDG Monitoring Committee and R&E Offices.
6. Collaboration – Continue partnerships with environmental agencies, NGOs, and communities on conservation efforts.

This policy takes immediate effect and shall guide MU's actions in protecting terrestrial ecosystems.
