Policy on Safe and Responsible Hazardous Waste Management (SDG 15)

Misamis University strengthens its policy on the safe handling, storage, treatment, and disposal of hazardous waste, in compliance with RA 6969, RA 9003, and University safety protocols. This applies to all chemical, biological, electronic, medical, and laboratory waste generated on campus.

- 1. Segregation** – Hazardous waste must be separated by type in labeled, sealed containers; mixing with regular waste is prohibited.
- 2. Safe Handling & Storage** – Only trained personnel may handle hazardous materials, which must be stored in designated secure areas with accessible SDS.
- 3. Treatment & Disposal** – Follow DENR/DOH guidelines for chemical and infectious waste; dispose of sharps in puncture-proof containers; send e-waste to DENR-accredited facilities; burning, burying, or dumping in regular bins is prohibited.
- 4. Monitoring & Compliance** – PCO and Laboratory Coordinators shall inspect facilities, maintain inventories, and submit reports.
- 5. Training** – Personnel must complete hazardous waste handling orientation and annual safety refresher courses.

All departments must enforce procedures, maintain logs, coordinate with PCO, and ensure student compliance.

This policy takes effect immediately and forms part of MU's environmental compliance system.
